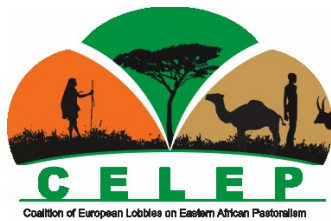
R1: Policies at national (EA) level are in line with AU FW on pastoralism

 - Report next AM



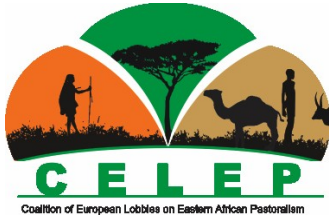
Result 2: EU and its' member states align development policies and funding to AU FW on pastoralism

 - **Organize a specific info-session** (FP – EU members).
 - Theme? Best Practices?
 - Lunch-conference Infopoint
 - Target Desk-officers Geographic unit DEVCO
 - Deadline: before the end of 2014 eg. Together with the AM (EA partners present)
 - Get in touch with local delegations (EA)
 - Roadmaps: Yes/no? 8 countries included pastoralism as a priority sector, among them Ethiopia (Ethiopia through Tufts University – Andy Catley)
 - Use updated flyer/leaflet
 - Before September and report next AM?
 - Exchange with DEVCO on technical note, suggest best practices/solutions,
 - Three best practices to promote: success stories: pastoralism and **Conflict** management/peace building, the total **economic value of pastoralism**: make one pager, **Climate change and pastoralism**
 - Info:
 - figures on EU funding going to pastoralism available soon
 - Visibility works: international journalists
 - Pastoralist journalist network (Kenya) – African Women and Child network
 - Action point for Ken: contact them for Turkana

 - List of African MPs to be sent to EA partners



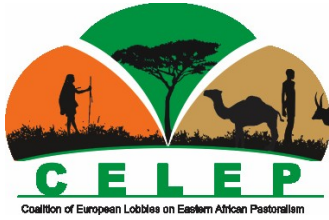

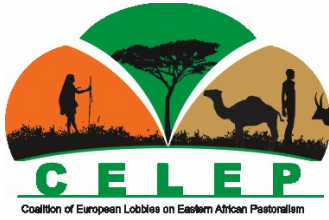

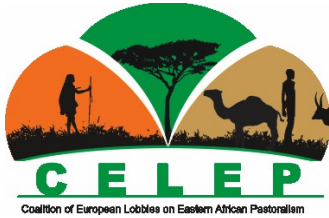
Result 3: Mainstreaming pastoralism in other development areas

- Policy briefs (gender as a cross-cutting theme) :
 - Nutrition: FP initiates, compiled with recommendations and suggestions Ggroup
 - Climate change (AWB and Wolfgang): based on previous one and reaction on The Economist
 - Land: Ken coordinates in EA and Alba in EU
- Practical Case:
 - Windmill-energy project Kenya
 - Resources are already there for the research
 - Consequences: disrupting communities, environmental assesment lacks, etc.
 - Objective: Research journalists (independent): invite them to write an article and research
 - Cordaid and EA coordinate
 - LAPSSET
 - Local colleague Cordaid working in Kenya on this
 - Example for Cordaid how pastoralist vision comes into extractives
